DEVOTIONAL HUMANS

GERMAN-ROMANIAN-BOSNIAN-POLISH YOUTH EXCHANGE







February 23 - March 3, 2019 (Germany) June 8 - June 16, 2019 (Romania)

Religious culture touches upon many rites and traditions, complex historical developments and recently also political debates. To name just one example, daily routines such as eating habits may ignite deep discussions about values and lifestyles, for instance when someone with a kosher or halal diet meets a vegan. The development of different religious communities and their coexistence within society also make for a fruitful starting point in getting to know a different culture. Finally, in all of Europe, there is public discourse on migration from the Arab world and the effects of Muslim traditions on predominantly Christian countries. Because those debates are often led by resentment, it is especially important and valuable that young people of different faiths and those who do not believe at all shall meet – in order to prevent them from developing stereotypes and prejudice.

In order to achieve this, GESW from Germany and Puzzle OptimEast from Romania are hosting an international youth exchange encompassing two activities, one in Vlotho (Germany) and one in Târgu Neamţ (Romania). In both countries a variety of different faiths and religious communities shape the culture: In Germany there are not only Catholic and Protestant Christians, but also a large Muslim minority. In Romania, there are Orthodox Christians professing the old or the new style, but also minorities of Protestants (Transylvania), Catholics (Hungarians and Danube Swabians), Muslims (Tatars) and Jews. While the activity in Germany is set in Westphalia, where the Thirty Year's War as a religious conflict was reconciled, the part in Romania will take place in one of the most spiritual places of Christian Orthodoxy, Western Moldavia.

Participants must be 26 years or younger and ready to participate fully in both activities. They must be able to speak English so well that they can follow the seminar contents. It is not necessary to belong to any faith; next to believers of any religion, we welcome agnostics and atheists. Openness to situations of interreligious and intercultural confrontation and the readiness to deal with one's own religious and cultural characteristics and to put the discoveries up for discussion are assumed. Participants should also be willing to actively engage in planning the program and conducting the meeting, and be curious about the interplay of religious and political spheres in different societies. We especially encourage participants that belong to religious or cultural minorities in their home countries.

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Participation Fee: Germans: 90€ (50€ for the activity in D, 40€ for the activity in RO)

Romanians, Bosnians, Poles: 45€ (25€ for D, 20€ for RO)

Travel Costs: Travel Costs will be partially refunded. Travel to an activity within the home country will be subsidized depending upon the distance to the location of

the activity. Travel to an activity abroad will be subsidised up to 275€.
