Living Diversity

German-Bosnian-Romanian-Polish youth exchange

August 9-August 17 (Germany)

October 3- October 12 (Bosnia and Herzegovina)

A project by Gesamteuropäisches Studienwerk e.V. (D) in cooperation with Dinara Forum/ Dinara l'Ateneu (BIH) , Puzzle OptimEast (RO) and Bad Badgers (Poland)

The coexistence of majority societies and old-established and new, immigrated ethnic minorities still shapes the political debates in the European countries. For example there are strong discussions about how a good integration of immigrated ethnic minorities can be achieved and about how multicultural societies can function. Furthermore the protection of minorities of old established ethnic groups is still not fully implemented in some European countries. Most recently emerging far-right parties and movements promote the concept of an ethnic homogenous nation and try to isolate and stigmatize ethnic minorities. The aim of the youth encounter is to show young people that ethnic minorities can be a cultural and social enrichment for the majority society. By talks to representatives of minority organizations the participants get in touch with the traditions and the identity of different minorities. They also learn about how minority organizations can provide possibilities of participation for members of an ethnic minority and how they can contribute to a better mutual cultural understanding.

In order to examine the topic of the youth encounter, GESW from Germany and Dinara Forum/ Dinara l'Ateneu will host two activities, one in Vlotho (Germany) and one in Ključ (Bosnia and Herzegovina). Both countries are characterized by the existence of large groups of new and old-established ethnic minorities: The region of Westphalia, in which the activity in Germany will take place, has been home to many different ethnic groups since the 1950s. Among them are for example communities from Turkey, Greece, Russia, Syria and Africa. Contrary to Germany, Bosnia and Herzegovina consists mainly of old-established ethnic groups. The main ethnic groups are Bosnian Muslims, Serbs and Croats. The activity in Germany gives a very good insight into current debates of integration and multiculturalism, whereas the second part in Bosnia and Herzegovina shows how Europe's most ethnically diverse political system functions.

Participants must be 26 years or younger and ready to participate fully in both activities. They need to have sufficient English skills in order to understand the seminar contents and participate actively in discussions. Moreover there should be openness towards situations of intercultural confrontation and a willingness to contribute actively to the program. Participants should have an honest interest in the cultural, social and political self-concept of ethnic minorities, too. We especially encourage young people that belong to ethnic minorities in their home countries.

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**Participation fee: Germans 85 € (for both activities)
Bosnians, Romanians, Poles> 35 € (for both activities)**

Travel costs: The travel costs of German participants to Vlotho will be refunded (A distance till 99 kilometer with up to 20 €, distances over 99 kilometer with up to 180 €). The journey to the second activity in Bosnia and Herzegovina will be subsidized with up to 275 €.

For the Bosnian, Romanian and Polish participants: Travel to an activity within the home country will be subsidized depending upon the distance to the location of the activity. Travel to an activity abroad will be subsidized up to 275€.
